Call to Order

In Attendance: President Roger Lubiens, Susan Lubiens, Phil Smith, Steve Heringer, Norman Wilson, Paul Baldwin, Larry French, Burl Rogers, Richard Marshall and Jim Marshall

Comment:

President Lubiens announced that this was the first in-person meeting in two years of Chapter 14.

While this meeting was held at the San Joaquin County Historical Museum at Micke Grove, the museum was actually closed due to Covid. Chapter 14 was given special permission to use one of their meeting rooms. Members were able to view one museum building which was open along with several outdoor displays of old farm equipment. Several large dredging clamshells used to reclaim the Delta and associated waterways were also on display.

Introductions: Attendees were invited to introduce themselves and comment on projects they were working on. Norm Wilson is working on a Super M, Paul Baldwin has projects of a 606 and 424, and Larry French has an O-4. Phil Smith who is from Georgia has a Farmall A which is in Georgia and he is attempting to get it moved to his location in Salinas. Richard Marshall has a UD-16 and several Farmall MD tractors. President Roger has several tractors in North Dakota specifically a 1466 and 656, a Super C and a Cub. He also has a Cub in Folsom, CA

Secretary Report: Jim Marshall read the minutes of a previous zoom meeting. Minutes were moved to be approved and was seconded by Steve Heringer.

Tax Reports: All tax reports filed as required and up to date.

Treasurer Report: \$11,546 in the treasury. \$3,800 was from government stimulus funds. Chapter 14 received \$800 in donations recently.

Membership Reports:

President Lubiens reported Chapter 14 currently has 199 paid members.

Sixty members used PayPal to renew their memberships. The PayPal system seems to be working well.

Unpaid memberships will expire April 30, 2022.

We were saddened to learn that member Jon Rogers passed away in December.

Member Tony Ramos has been quite ill and is now reported to be improving. We wish him well.

It was noted that Chapter 14 has membership in 8 different states and one in England. Chapter 14 has absorbed memberships from members of disestablished IHC chapters in Oregon and Washington, some of whom have joined Chapter 14. Most of the membership of Chapter 14 resides in Central California and approximately 40 members reside in Southern California.

Foundation Reports:

OAKDALE - Farmall A completely restored by Oakdale FFA. Will be kept on hand to service needs on 24 acre farm connected with this chapter of FFA. Farmall M is underway in being restored, being cleaned and steamed ready for painting.

YUBA COUNTRY CHARTER SCHOOL - Member Jeff McGill has volunteered to assist the Yuba County Charter School with its welding program and will be assisting with a restoration of a Farmall Cub tractor. Chapter 14 donated \$1,000 to this effort it being the 40th tractor restoration sponsored by Chapter 14.

WHEATLAND - Has an IH-300 tractor which has been in process for quite some time. Progress has been slow. Tractor needs a paint job.

Website: The Chapter 14 Facebook account has recorded 8,700 visitors viewing our posts.

Old Business:

Folsom Veterans Day Parade included 3 Farmall Cub tractors. 1,000's of people watched the parade.

Winter Meeting at Micke Grove Museum near Lodi, CA on 1-22-22 between 10AM-Noon featured a number of IH Collector members.
