IH Collectors Chapter 14, Inc Annual Meeting on Zoom Minutes May 7, 2022

Call to Order: President Lubiens called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m. on zoom.

In Attendance: President Roger Lubiens, Susan Lubiens, Phil Smith, Terry Sparr, Paul Baldwin, Richard Marshall and Jim Marshall, and Bernard Cargle.

Pledge of Allegiance to USA flag

Introductions: Roger introduced those members who were on the zoom call.

Secretary Report: Jim Marshall read the minutes of a previous zoom meeting. Minutes were approved.

Tax Reports: All required tax reports filed for IRS and California Franchise Tax Board and up to date.

Treasurer Report: \$8,802 in the treasury. \$3,800 was from government stimulus funds.

Membership Reports:
President Lubiens reported Chapter 14 currently has 203 paid members.
Unpaid memberships will expire April 30, 2022.
Member Tony Ramos had been quite ill, but is now much improved. He served as the chairman of the California Antique Farm Show in Tulare and did a good job.

Foundation Reports:
Foundation currently has \$9,110 in funds. Recently received a generous \$500 donation.
OAKDALE - Farmall A completely restored by Oakdale FFA. Will be kept on hand to service needs on 24 acre farm connected with this chapter of FFA. Starting on next project of a Farmall M tractor.
YUBA COUNTRY CHARTER SCHOOL - Member Jeff McGill has volunteered to assist the Yuba County Charter School with its welding program and will be assisting with a restoration of a Farmall Cub tractor donated by Darrell Taylor. Chapter 14 donated \$1,000 to this effort it being the 40th tractor restoration sponsored by Chapter 14.
WHEATLAND – Has an IH-300 tractor which has been in process for quite some time. Progress has been slow. Tractor needs a paint job.
PORTERVILLE – There has been an inquiry to Chapter 14 about assistance with a tractor restoration at this school. Chapter 14 is working with Titan Tires to see if tires can be donated for the tractor they are working on.

Website: The Chapter 14 Facebook account has recorded 112,000 visitors viewing our posts – up from 8,700 on previous report.

Old Business:

Folsom Veterans Day Parade included 3 Farmall Cub tractors. Large crowds of 1,000's of people watched the parade.

Winter Meeting at Micke Grove Museum near Lodi, CA on 1-22-22 between 10AM-Noon. Ten members attended.

Tulare show – very rainy prior to show threatening success of the show, but Saturday and Sunday has good weather and show was a success. Sold a number of caps and T-shirts. Signed up 2 new members. There were 750 people attending the steak dinner on Saturday. It was a good event. The tractor pull and parade were big attractions for visitors.

World Ag Expo in Tulare Feb 8-10, 2022.

Red Power Winter Convention was to be held March 24-26, 2022 in Pidgeon Forge, TN.
President Lubiens planned to attend. Due to a mix up with the hotel, the facility was double booked and the Winter Convention was cancelled for this year.

New Business:

Antique Truck Show scheduled for April 30, 2022 in Plymouth CA has had its date changed. The County Fairgrounds have been signed out to another group for the April date. According to the ATHS Central California website, the Truck Show will convene on June 11, 2022 in Plymouth. Last show had 218 antique trucks many of which were IH manufacture. Truck show will return to normal date in April next year.

Rio Linda Farm Show with parade and demos. May 13-14.

Best of the West Show in Santa Margarita May 27 – 30. Show includes parades and field demos.

Red Power Roundup (#33) June 23-25, 2022 will be in Springfield, Ohio hosted by Chapter 6.

Red Power Roundup (#34) June 15-17, 2023 will be in Grand Island, Nebraska hosted by Chapter 12.

Roger showed power point pictures of recent Tulare show.

Election of Officers and Board Members: President Lubiens respectfully requested that all current officers and board members continue on for the coming year. Those present agreed to continue to serve.

Open discussion:

- Paul Baldwin mentioned a big auction coming up near Clear Lake. Ad in Western Trader magazine.
- Roger mention that Farm Show magazine is requesting an article about Chapter 14. Roger is working on write-up and photos to be submitted.
- Terry Sparr expressed condolences regarding the passing of member Cary Stockton who was a great supporter of Chapter 14.
- Phil told the group about the mima mounds which were naturally occurring in the California valleys prior to reclamation and farming. These mounds can be about 4 ft. high from bottom of swale to top of mound.
- Susan Lubiens read to us a piece from the internet regarding mima mounds.
- Jim let the group know about the Great Oregon Steam Up which will be held on the grounds of Powerland Heritage Park in Brooks, Oregon. The park is located on approximately 62 acres and has 14 different museums. Some of the museums are Caterpillar, Antique Trucks (brand new \$1 million building), Oregon Vintage Machinery Museum featuring John Deere, Fire Trucks, Logging, Steam Sawmill, Steam tractors, Steam powered railroad crane, Antique Automobile museum, EDGE Chapter 15 (flywheelers), large engine barn and many more. Steam Up is held the last weekend of July and first weekend of August the typically attracts approximately 5,000 visitors.
- Roger reported that North Dakota has had severe rains and flooding. Some of his property is under water. This can often create some big pot holes.
- Terry Sparr says they have big pot holes in Pennsylvania too – maybe bigger!
